Clifton Road, St. Thomas's Winchester. In 1891 she was also living with Mary Bramston but the relationship was not then noted. The address in 1891 was 41, Dingwall Road, Croydon and Mary Bramston is then listed as both author and boarding house mistress. (2) Mary Elizabeth König, aged 1 year is listed in 1911 census as "visitor" from St. Cross, Winchester – Kathleen living at Edward Road, Kingshot, Winchester with Mary E Branstom who is living on private means. No occupation given for Kathleen who is listed as Kathleen Muriel Koenig and described as an adopted niece. Paul König died August 8 1933, Gnadau, Germany. Kathleen Muriel is described as a widow in Effie's will when probate was given (Effie died 1923).Kathleen d. 1943 in registration district of Surrey. Her name registered as Kathleen M. Koenig-Pennington. Probate record shows date of death 22 April 1943, name Kathleen Muriel Koenig or Koenig-Pennington. Address Chiswell Lodge, The Avenue, Worcester Park, Surrey (widow) administration to Mary Elisazbeth Koenig-Pennington (spinster). Effects £1093 10s 3d. It appears at some point the surname Koenig-Pennington was adopted as daughter Mary can be found using this name on travel documents from New York to Southampton in 1932. Mary became an actress under the stage name "Ann Muncaster". She died Alresford nr. Winchester, 1993.
